Tools, Adhesives & Ink:

Paper trimmer, scissors, scoring tool, bone folder, ruler, craft knife, foam adhesive, pencil, various adhesives, Optional: coordinating ink and applicator, corner punch

Notes:

- All measurements are width x height, unless specified.
- When cutting papers, be mindful of the pattern direction.
- If desired, use coordinating ink to distress paper edges.
- Reserve one cut-apart sheet per season for cutting images and borders.


Directions:



1. Take Spring Floral and cut a 12" x 6" from the bottom of the paper; trim into one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6", one $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x 6", and one $6\frac{1}{8}$ " x 6". Use leftover paper to cut off a $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x 6" piece.

2. Find one May calendar ephemera card (b-side) and the spring chipboard frame measuring about 4" tall. Adhere the frame over the sentiment "Life in Bloom"; trim off paper along the

3. Open your album and place it face-down. Center and adhere the Spring Floral papers. Then adhere the chipboard frame to the center of the 23/4" x 6" piece.







4. Remove the teapot image from Spring Cut-Apart; it will roughly measure $4" \times 5\%$ ". Then remove the double stamp image (cut stamps as one whole piece). Locate the April calendar ephemera card (b-side); fussy cut the oval shape with flowers. Then locate the green chipboard frame, stack of teacups chipboard tag, and "A Season to Celebrate" sentiment.

5. Close the album; the front cover should be face-up. Adhere the teapot image to the left side of the front







cover. Then layer and adhere the remaining pieces to the front of the magnetic closure. Make sure to adhere the stamp image to the back of the green chipboard frame.

6. Find Autumn Floral (b-side)

> and cut a 12" x 6"; cut into two 6" squares. Cut a 2%" x 6" from leftover paper.



Take Winter Floral and cut a 12" x 5½"; trim into two $5\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Cut a $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " from leftover paper. Center and adhere these papers over the Autumn Floral (b-side) papers as shown.

7. Inside left cover: Center and adhere one set of papers. Remove dark blue border from Winter Cut-Apart; trim to 5½" long. Adhere just the top and bottom to make a belly band. Remove "Premium Season Winter" and adhere to the belly band;



adhere small circle chipboard. Trim "Life in Bloom" border from Spring Cut-Apart to 6"; adhere to spine.



8. Inside right cover: Repeat step 7 using remaining papers, leftover blue border, and pair of stamps (cut as one piece) from Winter Cut-Apart. Adhere small chipboard tag. Adhere green chipboard tag to the spine. Adhere 6" long "Tis the Season" border from Winter Cut-Apart to the far left side of the magnetic closure

9. Remove "Celebrate the Winter Season" from Winter Cut-Apart; it will measure roughly 6" x 4". (Optional: round all four corners.) Score paper 4\%" from the left. Find a square tag, place it upside down, then adhere just the 43%" scored section to the tag.





10. Flip the tag over. Apply the rose rub-on transfer image to the upper right corner. Then place some double-sided tape behind the exposed 15%" x 4" scored section of the blue paper.

(The adhesive will go on the side of the paper that has the sentiment and flowers).



11. Page 1: Find your second sheet of Winter Floral (b-side) and cut a $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x 12". Trim two $5\frac{1}{4}$ " squares; save one for step 18. Keep remaining 63/4" x 12" for step 14. Center and adhere paper to Page 1. Attach

the 15%" x 4" section of the tag to the far right side of the paper. The tag should freely open and close; you will repeat this technique for the other seasons.







12. Locate one January calendar ephemera card. Trim the blue frame border off all sides so the card roughly measures 31/8" x 51/4". Score 1/2" horizontally from the top; place double-sided tape under the 1/2" scored section. You will repeat this technique to the remaining 11 month calendar

ephemera cards throughout the album.

13. Page 1 (back): Take your second sheet of Winter Cut-Apart (b-side) and cut a 51/4" x 12"; trim into two 5¹/₄" squares. Set one aside for step 35; keep remaining paper for step 16. Adhere one $5\frac{1}{4}$ " square. Attach the 1/2" scored section of the January calendar; adhere



a chipboard tag to just the calendar. Trim off a 51/4" long floral border from Winter Cut-Apart and adhere.



14. Page 2 and Page 2 (back): Take leftover Winter Floral from step 11 and trim to 5%" x 12". Cut two 5\%" x 3¼". Cut

two $5\frac{3}{8}$ " x $2\frac{1}{8}$ " and flip to the b-side. Trim off two $5\frac{3}{8}$ " long "Happy Winter" borders from Winter Cut-Apart. Adhere the borders to the top of the $5\frac{3}{8}$ " x $2\frac{1}{8}$ " papers. Then adhere a set of papers to each side of the page.

15. Page 3: Attach the February calendar ephemera card. Apply the blue floral outline rub-on transfer image. It may help to place a small book or other flat surface under the page while you apply the rub-on. Then adhere the large blue chipboard frame to just the February card.





16. Take leftover Winter Cut-Apart (b-side) from step 13 and cut a $4\frac{1}{8}$ " x 12". Trim into two $4\frac{1}{8}$ " x 4\%". (Optional: round corners.) Center and adhere onto both sides of a tag. Cut two 41/8" "Winter" borders from Winter Cut-Apart; ad-

here on top of the papers. Adhere a blue chipboard label to the far right edge. Insert into the pocket between Page 2 and Page 2 (back).

17. Repeat steps 9 and 10, keeping the tag upright this time, and using the "Celebrate the Spring Season" image from Spring Cut-Apart and purple floral outline rub-on transfer image.





18. Page 3 (back) and Page 4: Adhere Winter Floral 51/4"





square. Attach March card; adhere small square rose tag to just the card. Page 4: Find your second sheet of Spring Floral (b-side). Cut a 5¼" x 12" piece; trim into two 5¼" squares. Save one for step 24; keep remaining 6¾" x 12" piece for step 20. Center and adhere one square to the album. Then attach the Spring tag.



19. Page 4 (back): Take your second sheet of Spring Cut-Apart (b-side) and cut off a 51/4" square; center and adhere to the page. Save leftover paper for step 22. Then repeat step 13 using the Spring Cut-Apart floral border, April calendar ephemera, and spring chipboard tag.

20. Page 5 and Page 5 (back): Take 63/4" x 12" Spring Floral from step 18 and trim to



 $5\frac{3}{6}$ " x 12". From this piece, cut two $5\frac{3}{6}$ " x $2\frac{1}{6}$ "; flip to the b-side. Then cut two $5\frac{3}{8}$ " x $3\frac{1}{4}$ ". Repeat the rest of step 14 using the "Happy Spring" border from Spring



21. Page 6: Repeat step 15 using your second May calendar ephemera card, small floral chipboard frame, and spring bouquet rub-on transfer image.

22. Remove 4" x 4" "Life in Bloom" and a 41/8" long "Spring" border from Spring Cut-Apart. (Optional: round the corners.) Score paper 1/2" from the top horizontally; adhere just the scored section to a tag. Adhere purple chipboard



label to the paper. Cut a $4\frac{1}{8}$ " x $4\frac{3}{8}$ " piece from leftover Spring Cut-Apart (b-side) and adhere to the back of the tag; adhere border.



23. Repeat steps 9 and 10, using the "Celebrate the Summer Season" image from Summer Cut-Apart and Autumn dahlia rubon transfer image.



24. Page 6 (back) and Page 7: Adhere Spring Floral 51/4" square. Repeat step 18 with the June card and "Life in Bloom" chipboard. Page 7: Find Summer Floral (b-side) and cut a $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x 12" piece; trim into two $5\frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Save one for step 30; keep remaining paper for step 26. Center and adhere one square to the page; adhere summer tag.

25. Page 7 (back): Take your second sheet of Summer Cut-Apart (b-side) and cut off a 51/4" square; center and adhere to the page. Save leftover paper for step 28. Then repeat step 13 using the Summer Cut-Apart







floral border, July calendar ephemera, and "Hello Sunshine" chipboard tag.

26. Page 8 and Page 8 (back): Take leftover Summer Floral from step 24 and trim to $5\frac{3}{8}$ " x 12". From this piece, cut two $5\frac{3}{8}$ " x $3\frac{1}{4}$ ". Then cut two 5\%" x 2\%";

> flip to the b-side. Repeat step 14 using the "Happy Summer" border from Summer Cut-Apart.





27. Page 9: Repeat step 15 using the August calendar ephemera card, large sunflower chipboard tag, and "Hello Sunshine" rub-on transfer image.

28. Repeat step 16 using leftover Summer Cut-Apart (b-side) paper from step 25, "Summer" border, and red chipboard label.



29. Repeat step 17, using the "Celebrate the Autumn Season" image from Autumn Cut-Apart and Autumn dahlia rub-on transfer image.





30. Page 9 (back) and Page 10: Adhere Summer Floral $5\frac{1}{4}$ " square. Repeat step 18 with the September card and dahlia chipboard. Page 10: Find your second sheet of Autumn Cut-Apart (b-side) and cut a 51/4" square; center and adhere to the page. Save leftover paper for step 32. Then attach the Autumn tag.



31. Page 10 (back): Take your second sheet of Autumn Floral (b-side) and cut off a 51/4" x 12" piece; trim off a 5¼" square. Center and adhere to the page. Save leftover paper for steps 32 and 34. Then repeat step 13 using the Autumn Cut-Apart floral border, October calendar

ephemera, and dahlia chipboard tag.







32. Page 11 and Page 11 (back): Take 6¾" x 12" leftover Autumn Floral

and trim off two $5\frac{3}{8}$ " x $3\frac{1}{4}$ ". Use leftover Autumn Cut-Apart (b-side) from step 30 and cut two $5\frac{3}{8}$ " x $2\frac{1}{8}$ ". Repeat the rest of step 14 using the "Happy Autumn" border from Autumn Cut-Apart.



33. Page 12: Repeat step 15 using the November calendar ephemera card, "Thanks & Giving" chipboard tag, and burgundy floral outline rub-on transfer image.

34. Repeat step 22 using "Happy Harvest" from *Autumn* Cut-Apart and an orange chipboard label. For the reverse, use leftover Autumn Floral (bside) and "Autumn Season" border.



35. Page 12 (back): Center and adhere 51/4" Winter Cut-Apart (b-side). Repeat step 18 with the December calendar and "Warm & Cozy" chipboard.





Place the tags into the corresponding pockets and decorate with photos and keepsakes.
